UPDATE ON THE ALLEGATIONS OF CORRUPTION AGAINST THE TEACHING SERVICE COMMISSION (TSC)

The SNAT NEC hereby updates the General Membership [GM] regarding the Allegations of Corruption against the Teaching Service Commission as follows.

That;

1. On Wednesday (04-11-2020), the SNAT NEC did meet the Ministry of Education and Training (MoET) Parliament Portfolio Committee at 1130hrs wherein the allegations of corruption against the Teaching Service Commission (TSC) were tabled. The meeting resolved that a meeting of all the concerned parties be convened by the Education Portfolio Committee at a date to be announced. These parties are the Minister and her Principal Secretary, the TSC and the SNAT NEC. In this meeting, the SNAT NEC shall again table these allegations.
2. Today (05-11-2020), the SNAT NEC met the Parliament Public Accounts Committee (PAC) at 1000hrs to discuss the abuse of public resources and stealing of money from teachers through coercive means by certain Officers in the TSC. This meeting did not deliberate on the merits of the issues, owing to the fact that the same issues had already been discussed in greater detail with the Education Portfolio Committee on Wednesday as highlighted above.

The session agreed that since the Education Portfolio Committee is already seized with the issues, it is highly possible that some of its recommendations shall direct that the same PAC takes over the baton on some of those matters. Therefore, the meeting between the SNAT and the PAC was held in abeyance, pending the outcome of the issues as deliberated upon by the Education Portfolio Committee.

3. Again (05-11-2020), the SNAT NEC met with the Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) at 1130hrs to deliberate on these issues as well as following up on other issues that were referred to the Commission by the SNAT, a while ago. The process to investigate the cases was set in motion. A total of 33 cases of alleged corruption were tabled before the ACC.

4. Tomorrow (06-11-2020), all the comrades against whom garnishee orders had been effected by SP Mamba Attorneys, shall meet at the SNAT Centre to draft and sign affidavits on their respective cases. As the SNAT, we shall take this Law Firm and its director (Mr. Simanga Mamba) to court for such violation of basic legal procedures to be followed when effecting a garnishee order.

AS THE SNAT NEC, WE SHALL KEEP OUR MEMBERS ABREAST WITH DEVELOPMENTS ON THESE ISSUES AS DAYS GO BY.
